

MAINE ASSOCIATION OF ASSESSING OFFICERS 2024 LEGACY AWARD

The Award

The Legacy award is sponsored annually by the Maine Association of Assessing Officers (MAAO) to recognize years of dedicated service and excellence as a Maine assessor. The recipient of the Legacy award has left a footprint in the Maine assessing community through education, leadership, service, and a track record of high ethical standards.

Selection Process/Presentation of Award:

- 1) The selection committee shall be appointed by the MAAO Board of Directors. It may consist of the following:
- The Chair of the Awards and Scholarship Committee, the Awards and Scholarship Committee members and the MAAO Executive Board members.
- Immediate past recipient of the Legacy award.
- 2) The Committee shall solicit nominations from MAAO members and affiliates. **Deadline for nominations to be submitted is August 9, 2024.** Nominations will be submitted on the official MAAO Legacy Award Form.
- 3) The Committee shall not disclose the name of the recipient before the Awards Ceremony.
- 4) The Award will be given during the MAAO Fall Conference Annual meeting in September.

Criteria:

Nominees for this award shall meet the following criteria:

- 1) Have held the title of Assessor and be a current or former CMA.
- 2) Is recognized as an Assessor who displays characteristics of integrity and leadership.
- 3) Shall have at least twenty years of experience as an Assessor.
- 4) Have a record of ongoing professional development and educational improvement.
- 5) Is or was once active in a professional association for assessing with a published code of ethics.
- 6) Have authored articles or other forms of organized, disseminated information related to assessing.
